In pursuance of the State Project Directorate, Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA), Govt. of Manipur Order No. 60/SPD-RUSA/2020(Pt), One Day Awareness Programme on **National Education Policy (NEP) 2020** was successfully organized at Moreh College, Moreh under the initiative of IQAC, Moreh College on the 12th April, 2021 at the College Conference Hall.

The said programme started as scheduled (10.00am). It started with the welcome address delivered by. S. Norjit Singh followed by the keynote address from Dr. S. Shyamjai Singh, Co-ordinator, IQAC Moreh College. The Principal of the College however could not attend the programme due to ill health only at the eleventh hour.

During the technical session, apart from the two delegates/resource persons deputed by the Directorate, Shri Gojendro, ADC Moreh delivered motivational speech besides throwing few highlights on NEP-2020. He further pointed out the need to ensure quality education and stated that true development can take proper shape through ensuring proper education.

The main lecture on NEP 2020 was presented by Dr. M. Suresh Singh, Assistant Professor and mentor of Mission 2.5+ NAAC. He outlines the vision of India's new education system from NEP 2020 perspective. He also highlighted that the NEP proposes sweeping changes including opening up of Indian higher education to foreign universities, dismantling of the UGC and the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), introduction of a four-year multidisciplinary undergraduate programme with multiple exit options, and discontinuation of the M. Phil.

While explaining the core emphasis of NEP 2020, the speaker made clear how the NEP 2020 suggests a slew of reforms to school education, with a focus on flexibility of subjects and eliminating silos between streams of learning. Another goal of the NEP is to achieve 100 percent Gross Enrolment Ratio in preschool to secondary level by 2030. He further mentions that the New Education Policy will give importance to students' practical knowledge instead of just pushing them towards rote learning. It will help students to develop scientific temper from a young age.

Most importantly, Dr. M. Suresh Singh talks about the basic principles of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 and the vision of the policy. He also made a mention of how the policy will ensure multilingualism to promote languages to enable young children learn and grasp nontrivial concepts more quickly in their home language/mother tongue.

After an hour of highlights on NEP 2020, there was constructive discussion with the participants where questions and clarifications were asked. The resource person not only presented the talk on NEP lucidly, but answered all questions satisfactorily.

After the discussion, Dr. S. Dillipkumar Singh delivered the vote of thanks wherein he thanked the State Project Directorate, Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA), Govt. of Manipur for funding the programme and deputing learned and eloquent resource persons. Thereafter, the programme ended. Certificates are issued to all participants.
