Teaching Aids:

- a) Common needs inside a classroom- white board, marker, duster, pointer, etc.
- b) I.C.T tools, charts, maps, slides, projectors etc.
- c) Model pictures, samples, illustrations, globe etc.
- d) Tape-recorder, Lingua phone, headphone, cassettes etc.
- e) Desktop/Laptop, CDs, printer, scanner, etc.

General Aims:

- i) To teach the students for proper understanding of the lesson/chapter/poem/story, to read and speak with correct pronunciation, right pattern of falling and rising intonation.
- ii) To enrich vocabulary stock of students
- iii) To make them enable to write the substance/central idea/ gist/critical appreciation (poem), etc.
- iv) To make them acquainted with places and persons, events, dates (Pol. Sc./History/Education/ Economics)etc.
- v) To motivate them for further reading, studying and better understanding of the lesson taught.
- vi) To incite a sense of national integrity, unity, harmony, social-mindedness, etc.

Instructional Objectives:

It is based on the lesson/chapter at hand

Previous Knowledge:

If it is a continuation of a previous chapter/lesson, reference should be given first then, continue the same for complete understanding of the students.



INTRODUCTION:

The teacher will try to attract students mind to the day's lesson by referring to the previously learnt lesson. If a new chapter is taken up, a briefing should be done by giving some relevant points as the background.

Announcement of the day's lesson/chapter:

Next, the teacher will announce the lesson/chapter and page no. Then, he/she will try kjto draw the attention of the students for thorough understanding and comprehension of the lesson.

Presentation:

The teacher then will dwell on the text/ contents of the lesson thoroughly.

The terms and key words in the lesson will be elaborated for explained by using question and answer method.

Portable questions, turning points, references should be noted for better understanding of the students.

Recapitulation:

Thus, the teacher will ask some short answer type questions and let them give short and simple answer of their own. If correction is needed, it should be done in the same class.

Home Assignment:

Lastly, the teacher, if it deems necessary, will give some suggested/probable questions relating to the lesson taught in the class, as home assignment.
