1. Waikhom Mani Girls' College, Thoubal Okram, Thoubal District

Wakhom Mani Girls' College is located at Thoubal Okram, Thoubal District, Manipur and about 22 km from Imphal city. It was established on 20th Nov., 1980 by the local people, educationalist and social workers for the promotion of female higher education, where the woman literacy rate is very low in comparison to urban areas of Imphal East and West Districts of Manipur.

At the time of establishment the college was named as Thoubal Girls College. On 9th Feb., 1981, the foundation stone of the college was laid down at the present campus of Thoubai Okram village, besides the Indo-Myanmar Road, National Highway — 39.

Shri. Waikhorn Ahariba Singh donated Rs. I lakh for the construction of four class rooms and the college was rechristened to Waikhorn Mani Girls' College in honour of his father, Shri. waikhorn Mani Singh, Ex-Deputy Minister Education, Govt. of Manipur 1965.

This college is a private type institution, now converted to Govt-aided and UGC approved NAAC Accreditation Grade — B. The courses offered in this both Arts and Science Stream. They are Anthropology, Botany, Chemistry, Zoology, Home Science, Sociology, Geography, Education, Mathematics, Computer Science, Economics and various other courses including Vocational Courses and Career Oriented Courses.

Some of the facilities available are girls hostel, gym, auditorium, wi-fi, AC class rooms, IT Infra-structures, alumni associations, laboratories, parking facilities etc.
