About the College

Establishment:

Moreh College was established on 5th May, 1992 as a private co-educational college by late Shri. Tolhan Sanasam as a founder. The college was affiliated to Manipur University in the year 12th July 2005. The college is recognized by the UGC under section 2 (f) and 12 (B) of UGC Act, 1956 on 28th July 2006 and 15th June 2010 respectively. Altogether **20** subjects (B com. + 10 disciplines in Arts + 9 disciplines in Science) are offered in the college with 105 teaching staffs and 54 non-teaching staffs.

Location & its population:

Moreh College is the only higher educational institute teaching both undergraduate and graduate courses in the Tengnoupal district. Tengnoupal district (newly formed district in the year 2016) has been estimated to have a total population of 39245 souls (20269 males and 18976 females) [2011 census]. There are 96 villages in this district. It lies at N 24° 18' 39.996", E 94° 16' 35.2092" in global position. Moreh, a small town at the international boundary of India and Myanmar, constitutes about 43 percent of the districts population (16,847 souls). Moreh has an average literacy rate of about 61.04 %, slightly lower than the states average of 66.82% (2011 Census). Moreh College situates along international highway AH-1, and about 3 km distance from the Moreh town. Moreh is a town of multi ethnic population with diverse communities inhabited by the Kukis, Meitei, Tamil, Nepali, Punjabi, Telugu, Bihari, Marwari, and Meitei Pangals (Muslims) of which Kukis and Meities are the major communities.

Infrastructure:

The college has a separate blocks comprising of Administrative, Arts, Science and Commerce blocks. Each block has its own toilet facilities for both gender. Special importance is also given to physically challenge students as well. The building has a handicapped friendly railing. It has a multi auditorium hall where examination were conducted and indoor activities were carried out. It has wide space environment surrounded by different flora and fauna with a well-fortified boundary. Efforts are taken up to keep the campus a pollution free zone in Moreh Town. The college library has a collection of about 2227 + books and facilitates like e-journals, e-books through N- list programme provided from inflibnet. The library subscribes Journals and periodicals on different subjects. Funds for buying books are received from UGC and the State Government from time to time. In its recent development project the college has installed leased line connection from BSNL which is benefitted by both students and teachers.
